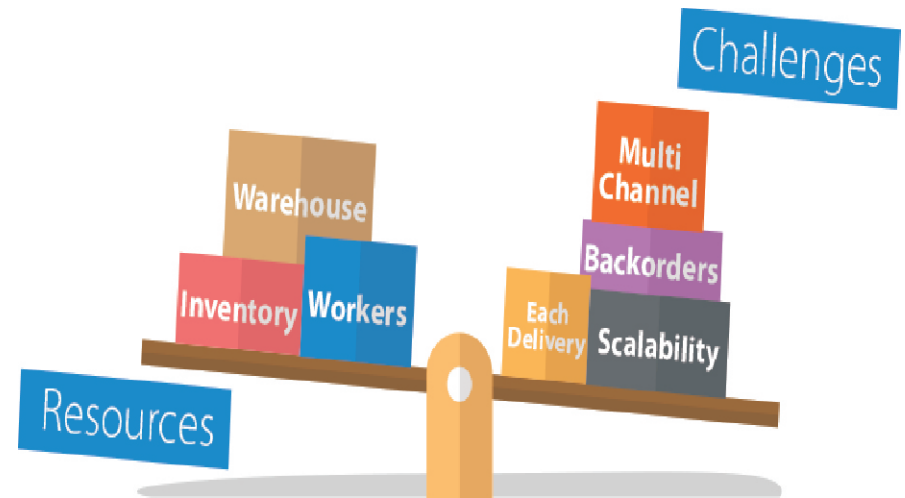

Need for Program

Warehousing and inventory constitute the backbone of any vibrant organization. Inventory ensures thorough implementation of production and supply strategies. Inventory management directly reduces cost and generates profit. Thorough inventory management ensures that there is no production or sales order loss.
